

### **WHO CAN ATTEND?**

Any current 9th, 10th or 11th grade student in an Adams 12 Five Star Schools' high school, charter school, or alternative high school may apply to attend FutureForward at Bollman or Washington Square in their 10th, 11th or 12th grade year.

### **WHAT CAN CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION COURSES DO FOR ME?**

Students "learn by doing" in Career and Technical Education (CTE). Courses combine rigorous academics with technical skills in hands-on learning environments. All CTE programs partner with business, industry and post-secondary institutions. These programs prepare students for the workforce and/or continuing education at 2- or 4-year colleges or apprenticeships in many career pathways.

### **WHAT KIND OF TEACHING CREDENTIALS DO THE TEACHING STAFF HAVE?**

FutureForward at Bollman and Washington Square faculty is comprised of certified teachers who are highly trained professionals in their specialized areas. Each teacher has at least five years of actual on-the-job related experience to complement their teaching skills.

### **HOW DO STUDENTS ENROLL FOR FUTURE FORWARD CLASSES AT BOLLMAN AND WASHINGTON SQUARE?**

Students sign up for FutureForward classes held at Bollman and Washington Square in February and March during the registration process at their home high school. More information is available on the registration page on our website <https://futureforward.adams12.org/>

### **HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?**

There are no tuition costs. However, some classes require a small fee and/or specialized materials.

### **HOW DO I GET TO BOLLMAN OR WASHINGTON SQUARE EACH DAY?**

Free district transportation is provided to and from the Bollman and/or Washington Square campuses for Horizon, Legacy, Northglenn, Thornton, Mountain Range, and Vantage Point High School students for most class periods.

### **DO CLASSES SATISFY GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS?**

All FutureForward at Bollman and Washington Square courses fulfill the district Fine/Practical Arts and/or Elective graduation requirements.

### **ARE COLLEGE CREDITS AVAILABLE?**

Concurrent Enrollment and with community colleges, 4-year colleges, and private post-secondary institutions allow students the opportunity to earn college credits in most FutureForward programs.
